MINUTES
of the
ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING



1890

A meeting of the International Board was held in London on Monday 2nd June 1890, all the delegates being present (Messrs Park & Campbell represented Scotland).

It was resolved to add Law 16 to Law 1 & thus include goal kicks in last clause of Law 9. Law 14 stand unaltered.

The Irish Association's proposals were withdrawn but it was resolved to legislate at next Annual Conference on the following lines viz:

" If any player shall deliberately trip or hold an
" opposing player or deliberately handle the ball within
" 12 yards of his own goal-line the referee shall,
" on appeal, award the opposing side a penalty kick,
" to be taken from any point 12 yards from the
" goal-line under the following conditions - All players
" with the exception of the player taking the penalty
" kick & the opposing goalkeeper shall stand behind
" the ball & at least 6 yards from it. The ball shall
" be in play when the kick is taken. A goal may
" be scored from the penalty kick "
