Protect the safety of the players
 Careless, reckless, excessive force
 Speed / Intensity / Point of contact
 Foot on the ground
 Illegal use of Arms
 Challenge for the ball / Possible to play the ball
 Clear action or grey zone
 Teamwork: Opinion / Decision / Confirmation

Penalty Area Incidents

Angle of view
 Proximity
 Obvious simulation = 100 percent no contact y the opponent
 If not 100 percent sure, play on
 Initiating or exaggerating contact
 Teamwork: Opinion / Decision / Confirmation

Tactical Offenses

SPA / DOGSO
 Considerations
 - Control of the ball / Clear possibility to control
 - Defenders / Attackers: number and location
 - Distance to the goal
 - Direction of play
 DOGSO: All conditions must be present for obvious goal-scoring opportunity
 Inside Penalty Area: **Attempt to play the ball**
 Teamwork: Opinion / Decision / Confirmation

Handling

Natural or Unnatural
 Hands on the body / Additional movement
 Deliberate action
 Taking a risk / Making the body bigger
 Promising attack / Disciplinary sanction
 Teamwork: Opinion / Decision / Confirmation

Reading the Game - Penalty Area

Main Priority = Penalty Area
 Proximity and angle of view
 See small details
 Anticipation
 Explosive movement / Reaction
 Teamwork / Responsibilities

 Priority of control: Law 11 vs Law 12
 Goal line / Touchline / Penalty Area
 Reaction, speed and explosive movement
 Concentration offside line / Running technique
 Wait and see
 Communication

Offside**General**

- Position / Concentration
- Teamwork / Communication
- Obvious action with impact on the ability of an opponent to play the ball
- Deliberate play vs. Save, Rebound or Deflection
- Action vs. Reaction
- Opinion / Decision / Confirmation

Interfering with Play

- Is a player in offside position?
- Play or touch the ball?
- Wait and see

Interfering with an Opponent

- Clearly obstructing line of vision
- Challenging the opponent for the ball / Immediate challenge
- Clear attempt to play the ball
- An obvious action with impact on the opponent's ability to play the ball
- Hindering / Delaying / Preventing defender from playing the ball
- Teamwork

Gaining an Advantage

- Rebound / Save
- Deliberate play
 - Player goes to play the ball = ACTION
 - Options / Can see the ball
 - Control of the body / No matter the outcome
 - Distance / Space
- Deflection
 - The ball goes to the player = REACTION
 - No options / No plan / Cannot see the ball
 - No control of the body
 - Never expect players doing nothing

Shot on goal = SAVE
